SCHEDULING ORDER

The Court hereby enters a scheduling order for the Bacterial trial cases.

I. EXPERT WITNESS DISCOVERY SCHEDULE

A. Expert Witness Reports

Plaintiffs will produce expert witness reports relating to non case specific causation by November 1, 2008. Defendants will produce defendants' expert witness reports relating to non case specific causation by December 15, 2008.

B. Expert Depositions

Plaintiffs' expert witnesses shall be deposed between January 1, 2009 and January 31, 2009. Defendants' expert witnesses shall be deposed between February 1, 2009 and March 1, 2009.

II. SCHEDULE DAUBERT/FRYE MOTIONS**A. Motions and Briefing Schedule**

The parties shall file an *Daubert/Frye* motions on or before March 23, 2009. Opposition briefs and memorandum shall be filed on or before April 10, 2009. Reply briefs and memoranda shall be filed on or before April 20, 2009.

B. Hearing on Motions

A Joint *Daubert/Frye* hearing will be held on May 4, 2009.
